

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL**  
**(BOWLER AVENUE)**  
**(PARKING PLACES, WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2024**

1. Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on **22 November 2024** it made the above Order under Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on **26 November 2024**. The effect of the Order will be:
2. To introduce 2 metres of "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction in **Bowler Avenue**, *south side*, outside Windlesham House at the proposed entrance for waste collection access at the development
3. To extend the existing "No Waiting at Any Time" restriction on the *south side* of **Bowler Avenue** from the western kerbline with Milton Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 2.5 metres
4. To update the Traffic order to reflect the yellow lines and parking bay markings currently on the road
5. Copies of the made Order, Statement of Reasons and the plan showing the restrictions are available to view on Portsmouth City Council's website: Search "Traffic Regulation Orders 2024" at [www.portsmouth.gov.uk](http://www.portsmouth.gov.uk). 6. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
