

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)
(DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (P056-24)**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 20 November 2024 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on **22 November 2024**, to effect:

A) To introduce Parking places for Disabled Persons (Minimum length 5 metres) in the following locations:
