

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (BRAMBLE ROAD)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2024**

1. Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 11 December 2024.
2. The effect of the Order will be to:
 - a. extend the existing "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) in **Bramble Road, south side**, for additional 3 metres westwards alongside the property No 51 Talbot Road; and
 - b. extend the existing "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) in **Talbot Road, west side** for a total length of 5 metres

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act, or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
