Corrigenda run a fleet 32 Electric Vehicles. Based on 10,000 miles, the CO2 emission saving is 1.2 tonnes per year/per EV when compared to the average ICE vehicle

30% of our 107 Corrigenda Vehicles are Electric

This Calculates to 38 Tonnes of CO2 Emissions Per Year!!
