THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (MARKET WAY CAR PARK) (OFF STREET CAR PARK) (No.1) ORDER 2025

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order would be:

- a) For Portsmouth City Council to take over management of Market Way Car Park located in the City Centre on **16 May 2025**.
