**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)
(DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS)
(P003-25 Part A) ORDER 2025**

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 25 April 2025 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 28 April 2025.

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.

Binsteed Rd.	North	from a point 1 metre west from the property boundary of Nos 35/37 for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction
Chichester Rd.	South	from the property boundary of Nos 48/50 in a westerly direction for 6 metres
Collington Cresce	South	from the property boundary of Nos 13/15 for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction
Eastwood Rd.	West	from a point 1 metre north from the southern property boundary of No. 1 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Elmwood Rd.	South-west	from a point 1 metres west from the eastern property boundary of No. 21 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
Farmlea Rd.	East	from the property boundary of Nos 8/10 for 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Folkstone Rd.	East	from the property boundary of Nos 48/50 for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Glenthorne Rd.	West	from the property boundary of Nos 11/13 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction
Gruneisen Rd.	North	from the property boundary of Nos 36/38 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Highgrove Rd.	West	from the property boundary of Nos 33/35 for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction
Laburnum Grove	North	from the eastern boundary of property No. 119 for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction

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Leominster Rd.	South	from a point 1 metre west of the property boundary of Nos 39/41 for a distance of 5.5 meters in a westerly direction
Lawrence Rd.	East	from a point 1 metre north from the property boundary of Nos 118/120 for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction
Meon Rd.	North	from the property boundary of Nos 101/103 for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Monckton Rd.	North	from the property boundary of Nos 11/13 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Moorland Rd.	East	from the property boundary of Nos 65/67 for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Myrtle Grove	West	from the property boundary of Nos 40/42 for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Oakwood Rd.	South-west	from the property boundary of Nos 51/53 for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Percival Rd.	East	from the property boundary of Nos 26/28 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Stanley Avenue	South-west	from the property boundary of Nos 2/4 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Thurbern Rd.	North	from the western property boundary of No.65 for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction
Westover Rd.	West	from the property boundary of Nos 65/67 for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction
Winstanley Rd.	South	from the eastern boundary of property No. 115 for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction
