

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)
(DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS) (No. 3) ORDER 2025**

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of the powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council ((Various Roads) (Disabled Persons' Parking Bays) (No. 3) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on the 14.04.2025

INTERPRETATION

2. In this Order:
 - (I) "Principal Order " shall mean The Portsmouth City Council Portsmouth City Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2022, as amended
 - (II) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (III) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

3. The contents of Schedule 1 shall be deleted from Schedule 1 to the Principal Order
4. The contents of Schedule 2 shall be added to Schedule 1 to the Principal Order

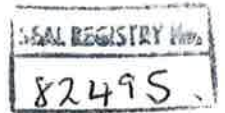

Schedule 1 - Parking place for Disabled Persons - addition

Road	Side	Description
Karen Avenue	South	From a point 3 metres east of the eastern highway boundary of Lower Drayton Lane eastwards for 5.5 metres

Schedule 2 - Parking place for Disabled Persons - deletion

Road	Side	Description
Lower Drayton Lane	east	From its junction with Karen Avenue for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
