

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)  
(DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (P064-24 Part B)  
ORDER 2024**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order, the effect of which would be:

**A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:**

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.

| Road             | Description     |
|------------------|-----------------|
| Brompton Road    | outside No.37   |
| Hayling Avenue   | outside No 156  |
| Powerscourt Road | outside No. 217 |

- B) To reduce the length of the No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions on the west side of Hayling Avenue to accommodate installation of a Disabled Bay outside No.156
