

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ZONE GB) (RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2025

Portsmouth City Council is proposing to increase the time limit from three to four hours for non-permit holders to be able to park on the south and east side of Priory Crescent, and the north side of Goldsmith Avenue (between Priory Crescent and Milton Road). The reason for the proposal is to facilitate use of the on-street parking places by users of the bowling greens in Milton Park.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- a) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
