

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ST. NICHOLAS STREET AREA & HEYWARD ROAD) (SCHOOL STREETS) Order 2024

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 28 July 2025 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 30 July 2025.

The effect of the Order will be to make permanent the provisions of the Experimental Order The Portsmouth City Council (St. Nicholas Road Area & Heyward Road) (School Streets) (Experimental) Order 2024:

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles (except for permit-holders) on the following roads between the hours of 8.15 - 9.00 am and 2.45 - 3.30 pm, Monday to Friday: -

Farthing Lane	For its entire length
Halfpenny Lane	For its entire length
Peacock Lane	For its entire length
Pembroke Close	For its entire length
Penny Street	From its junction with Pembroke Road to its northern closed end
Poynings Place	For its entire length
St. Nicholas Street	For its entire length
Wyndham Place	For its entire length

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles (except for permit-holders) on the following road between the hours of 8.30 - 9.15 am and 3.00 - 3.45 pm, Monday to Friday: -

Heyward Road	For its entire length

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks

from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
