

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (P013-25) ORDER 2025

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 30 July 2025 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 1 August 2025.

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.
