

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS
PARKING PLACES) (No. 3) (PART B) ORDER 2025**

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of the powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (No. 3) (Part B) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on the **29 September 2025**

INTERPRETATION

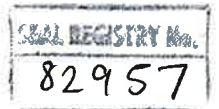
2. In this Order:
 - (I) "Principal Order " shall mean The Portsmouth City Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022, as amended
 - (II) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (III) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

SCHEDULE 1 - Disabled Parking Bays (Additions)

Road	Side	Description
Epworth Road	South	From the property boundary of Nos 8/10, for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Epworth Road	North	From a property boundary of Nos. 11/13, for a distance of 5.5 2metres in an easterly direction
Landguard Roa	South	From a point 2.2 metres west of the property boundary of Nos 17/19, for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Westbourne Road	East	From the property boundary of Nos 46/48, for a distance of metres in a southerly direction
