(DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (PART A) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 14 November 2025 made the above Order.

The Order comes into operation on 17 November 2025 to effect:

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.
