

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (PROHIBITED MOVEMENTS) (CONSOLIDATION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Portsmouth City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order shall come into operation on 22nd December 2025 and may be cited as the Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Prohibited Movements) (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2025.

2. Interpretation

In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned them:-

"enactment" includes any subordinate legislation within the meaning of the Interpretation Act 1978;

"hours of operation" means the hours shown in Column 5 of Schedules 1 and 2.

3. Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

5. Banned Turns

(a) Save as provided in Article 9, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in any of the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 in the direction specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to make the turn described in column 3 of Schedule 1 into the road specified in column 4 of Schedule 1 during the times specified in column 5 of Schedule 1.

6. Compulsory Traffic Movements

(a) Save as provided in Article 9, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in any of the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 in the direction specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to make any turn or movement other than that described in column 3 of Schedule 2 at the junction with the road specified in column 4 of Schedule 2.

7. Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

(a) Save as provided in Article 9, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 3.

8. Exemptions

Nothing in Articles 5, 6 and 7 shall apply to any vehicle in the following circumstances:

- (a) The vehicle is being used for at least one of the following purposes:
 - (i) Fire and rescue authority
 - (ii) Ambulance
 - (iii) Providing a response to an emergency at the request of an NHS ambulance service
 - (iv) Bomb or explosive disposal
 - (v) Special forces
 - (vi) Police
 - (vii) National Crime Agency
- (b) Nothing in Articles 6 and 7 shall apply to a vehicle being used in connection with:-
 - (i) any building operation or demolition;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 in or near any road; or
 - (v) the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;

provided that in all circumstances the observance of one or more provisions of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used
- (c) The vehicle is being used on or behalf of a statutory undertaker in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the observance of one or more provisions of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used
- (d) The vehicle is being used on or behalf of a local authority in pursuance of a statutory power or duty where the observance of one or more provisions of this Order would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used
- (e) Anything done:-
 - (i) with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, or any person duly authorised by the Portsmouth City Council Network Manager;
 - (ii) in accordance with any indication given by a traffic sign which has been placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

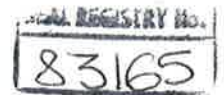
