

PUBLIC NOTICE



THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (STAMSHAW LAKE) (OFF STREET CAR PARK) ORDER 2025

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order would be to introduce a time limit for Stamshaw Lake car park of 4 hours, no return within 4 hours 6am - 6pm every day. (no time limit would apply for disabled blue badge holders and Stamshaw Lake car park permit holders).

Representations must be sent to TROteam@portsmouthcc.gov.uk or by post to TRO team, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Portsmouth PO1 2NE, quoting ref P001-25 within 28 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by **2 January 2026**) stating the grounds for the objection.
