

PUBLIC NOTICE



THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (CHICHESTER ROAD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2025

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order would be:
 - a) To extend the existing "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) for a total length of 10 metres on the north and the south side of Chichester Road as follows:

South side: outside the Lucky Panda Takeaway, property No.76, and

North side: outside the property number 63.
