THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (Ref. P039-2025) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 5 January 2026 made the above Order.

The Order comes into operation on 12 January 2026 to effect:

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.
