PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ARUNDEL STREET

1. Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: The Portsmouth City Council (Arundel Street) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 2026 The effect of the Order would be:
 - a) To reduce "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions in **Arundel Street**, *south side*, from 57 metres west of its junction with Fratton Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.

3. Persons wishing to object to or make other representations with regard to these proposals must do so in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made. Representations must be sent to TROteam@portsmouthcc.gov.uk or by post to TRO Team, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Portsmouth PO1 2NE, quoting ref P005-26 within 21 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by **20 March 2026**) stating the grounds for the objection. Please note that information on this consultation will be shared with Balfour Beatty, working in partnership with the City Council.
