

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS
PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) ORDER 2025**

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of the powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION

1. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on the **9 February 2026**

INTERPRETATION

2. In this Order:
 - (I) "Principal Order" shall mean The Portsmouth City Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022, as amended
 - (II) Except where otherwise stated, any reference to an Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that Article or Schedule in this Order.
 - (III) Any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactments.

AMENDMENTS

3. The contents of Schedule 1 shall be added to Schedule 1 to the Principal Order

Road	Side	Description
Whale Island Way	North	From a point 6.2 metres east of the eastern boundary of No.142 for a distance of 5.3 metres in an easterly direction

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 2 February 2026 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 9 February 2026.

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.
