

Proposed installation and removal of Disabled Parking Bays, Various Roads

1. Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places and Amendments) (No1) 2026.

2. **The effect would be as follows:**

- a) **To introduce enforceable disabled bays in the following locations.:**

Garnier Street - Outside no. 13
Hilsea Crescent - Outside no. 145
Kimbolton Road - Outside no. 24

- b) **To remove disabled bays in the following locations**

3. The bays would be available for use by Blue Badge holders only at all times. The Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the council must be displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle at all times when using the bay.
