

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (P034a-25) ORDER 2025

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 27 February 2026 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 6 March 2026.

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.

Road	Side	Description
Allen's Road	North	From the western property boundary of No.19 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Binsteed Road	South	From the western property boundary of No.6 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Cheltenham Road	South	From the eastern kerb line of the layby outside No.37, for a distance of 2.4 metres in a westerly direction
Chesterfield Road	East	From the southern boundary of No.98 for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction
Cressy Road	West	From a point 14 metres north of the northern kerbline of Sultan Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Cressy Road	East	From a point 0.7 metres north of the southern property boundary of No.32 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Dartmouth Road	East	From the northern property boundary of No.12 for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Epworth Road	South	From a point 2.4 metres east of the western property boundary of No.14 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
Harwich Road	North	From a point 2.8 metres east of the western property boundary of No.9 for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Hudson Road	North	From the western property boundary of No.25 for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Hunter Road	North	From a point 1.1 metres west of the eastern property boundary of No.2 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
Owen Street	West	From a point 0.8 metres south of the northern property boundary of No.46 for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Paulsgrove Road	West	From the southern property boundary of No.69 for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction
Wimpole Street	South	From a point 6 metres west of the eastern flank wall of Wigmore House (No.16-24)
Wymering Lane	East	From a point 4 metres south of the northern boundary of No.72, for a distance of 8.2 metres in a northerly direction

B) TO REMOVE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (NO LONGER REQUIRED) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:
