

PUBLIC NOTICE

PROPOSED RENTAL E-SCOOTER AND E-BIKE PARKING BAYS

1. Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Rental E-Scooter and E-Bike Parking Bays) Order 2026
2. The effect of the Order would be to introduce designated parking bays (6 metres long) for rental e-scooters and rental e-bikes at the following locations:

Road	Side	Description
Alver Road	South	Alongside 264 Fratton Road (<i>in place of Parking for Permit Holders</i>)
Cambridge Road	South-East	Opposite Armed Forces Careers Offices (<i>In place of the Pay and Display parking place</i>)
Tamarisk Close	West	Alongside No.1 Grand Division Row flats on Henderson Road
Hanway Road	West	Outside the block of flats Nos. 2-18
Jervis Road	South	Outside No.219 Jervis Road
Harbour Way	West	Opposite No.17 Harbour Way. (<i>within RPZ -FJ Stamshaw North</i>)
Amberley Road	North	Alongside No.439 Copnor Road
Spinnaker Drive	North	The north-west end, in the lay-bay adjacent to the playground.
Tregaron Avenue	West	Outside No.48a Tregaron Avenue
