PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS, MOORINGS WAY

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: The Portsmouth City Council (Waiting Restrictions) (Moorings Way) Order 2025

The effect of the Order would be:

1. To introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) on Moorings Way - east side, approximately 38 metres long, between the marked bus stop opposite Nos 202-206 and its junction with Furze Lane.

3. Persons wishing to object to or make other representations with regard to these proposals must do so in writing, stating the grounds on which they are made. Representations must be sent to TROteam@portsmouthcc.gov.uk or by post to TRO team, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Portsmouth PO1 2NE, quoting ref P060-25 within 21 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by **13 March 2026**).
