No work is to commence until the permit form has been issued by the Manager.

NOTE The maximum outside measurements for lawn style memorials erected within the Portsmouth City Council Cemeteries are shown below:

Grave Type	Height	Width	Depth
Childs Grave	2'6" (750mm)	1'6" (375mm)	1'0" (300mm)
Adults Grave	3'6" (1050mm)	2'6" (750mm)	1'6" (375mm)
Mini Kerb	3'6" (1050mm)	2'6" (750mm)	3' (914mm)

The minimum thickness of a lawn style memorial is:

2" (50mm) up to 1'6" (450mm) in height and 3" (75mm) from 1'6" (450mm) to 3'6" (1050mm) in height.

All lawn style memorials to be constructed of solid natural stone and securely doweled.
