

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES) (No.2) ORDER 2026 (P002-2026)

Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 14 May 2026 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 18 May 2026.

A) TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.

Road	Side	Description
Adair Road	East	From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Highland Road, for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction
Allaway Avenue	North	From a point 14 metres west of the western boundary of No.202, for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Ayelen road	East	From the northern boundary of No.67, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction
Beresford Road	West	From the northern boundary of No.25, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction
Chelmsford Road	West	From the southern boundary of No.57, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Chichester Road	South	From the eastern boundary of No.84, for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Compton Road	South	From the eastern boundary of No.104, for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
Earlsdon Street	West	From a point 27 metres south of the northern flank wall of Stratford House (No.8-39), for a distance of 3.2 metres in a southerly direction and 5 metres in an easterly direction
Eastfield Road	North	From the western property boundary of No.90, for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Harold Road	West	From the northern boundary of No.59, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction
Hillsley Road	Northwest	From the northwestern boundary, of No.14 for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southeasterly direction
Kimberley Road	East	From a point 3 metres south of its junction with Lindley Avenue, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction
Langstone Road	South	From the eastern boundary of No.26, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
Lindisfarne Close	East	From a point 8 metres north of its junction with Park Lane, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction
Maxwell Road	South	From the eastern boundary of No.10, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
North End Avenue	North	From the eastern boundary of No.46, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction

Portchester Road	North	From the western boundary of No.9, for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction
Powerscourt Road	North	From the eastern boundary of No.157, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
Radnor Street	South	From the eastern boundary of No.26, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction
St Barbara Way	South	In layby south side from a point 3 metres west of the western kerbline of St Barbara Way for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction
