

STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROPOSED PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS, TANGIER ROAD

The proposal is to manage the kerbside space on Tangier Road to provide users with the ability to access nearby facilities (e.g. for dog walking, sports), to deter vehicles being parked for long periods of time and to reduce vehicle speeds. This would be achieved by introducing restrictions in the form of "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines), and time- limited parking bays. The proposed times for the parking bays are 4 hours no return within 4 hours, 8am-6pm Monday-Sunday.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- a) For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
- b) To improve road safety

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
