

STATEMENT OF REASONS

ROAD HUMPS, CHARLOTTE STREET, CHARLES DICKENS

Portsmouth City Council proposes to introduce a road hump in the form of a raised table at the existing zebra crossing in Charlotte Street between its junction with Landport View its westernmost junction with Brewer Street and to extend the existing raised table near Commercial Road.

The reason for the proposal is to reduce the speed of vehicles traversing the road and improve accessibility for walking, wheeling and cycling for pedestrians.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- a) For improving road safety and enjoyment in the area through which the road runs.
- b) For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
