

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (No.3) ORDER 2026

1. Portsmouth City Council hereby gives Notice that on the 26 June 2026 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into effect on 30 June 2026.
2. The effect of the Order will be:

A) TO REMOVE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) FROM THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the above locations.

B TO INTRODUCE DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH) IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at the following locations.

Baffins Road	West	From the northern boundary of no. 17, southwards for 9.2 metres
Balliol Road	West	From the northern boundary of no. 55, southwards for 5.5 metres
Bonchurch Road	South-East	From the eastern boundary of no.22, westwards for 5 metres
Broom Close	East	From a point 3 metres west of boundary between flat no's 7-12 and 13-18, eastwards for 5.5 metres
Cyprus Road	North	From the western boundary of no. 1, eastwards for 6 metres

Cyprus Road	North	From a point 2 metres west of the eastern boundary of no.19, westwards for 6 metres
Glenthorne Road	East	From the southern boundary of no. 30, northwards for 5.5 metres
Grove Road	South	From the western boundary of no. 64, eastwards for 5 meters
Guildford Road	East	From the southern boundary of no. 57, northwards for 5.5 metres
Howard Road	East	On the east side of the outer side, from a point of 13 metres from the boundary of block 86-96, southwards for 5.5 metres
Inhurst Road	North	From the western boundary of no. 21, eastwards for 5.5 metres
Laburnum Grove	North	From the western boundary of no. 51a, eastwards for 5 metres
Leominster Road	East	From the eastern boundary of no. 37, westwards for 5.5 metres
Maidstone Crescent	North	From the western boundary of no. 8, eastwards for 5.5 metres
North End Grove	South	From the kerb line of the southern closed end, eastwards for 6 metres
Pervin Road	East	From the southern boundary of no. 10, northwards for 5.5 metres
St Augustine Road	West	From the northern boundary of no. 127, southwards for 6 metres
Stamshaw Road	West	From the northern boundary of no. 123, southwards for 5.5 metres
Stanford Close	North	From the boundary of no.12, eastwards for 3.6 metres
Station Road	East	From the northern boundary of no. 49, southwards for 5.5 metres
Stirling Street	South	From a point 11 metres of the western kerb line of Kingston Road, westwards for 5.5 metres
Tennyson Road	East	From the southern boundary of no. 10, northwards for 5 metres
Turner Road	North	North side, adjacent to No.1 Buckingham Green
Westfield Road	South	From the eastern boundary of no. 29, westwards for 5 metres
Westfield Road	North	From the western boundary of no. 228, eastwards for 5 metres
