

STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS, VECTIS WAY / HIGH STREET, COSHAM

Portsmouth City Council proposes to introduce road humps in the form of a raised table at the existing zebra crossings in High Street between its junction with Vectis Way and Magdala Road, and at Vectis Way at its junction with High Street, and a standalone raised table in High street, outside No.101a High Street.

The reason for the proposal is to reduce the speed of vehicles using the road and improve accessibility for walking, wheeling and cycling.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- a) For improving road safety and enjoyment in the area through which the road runs.
- b) For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).
