

Proposed installation and removal of Disabled Parking Bays, Various Roads

1. Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the following Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; The Portsmouth City Council (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (No. 6) Order 2026.

2. The effect would be as follows:

a) To introduce enforceable disabled bays in the following locations.:

Bredenbury Crescent - Outside no.4
Broom Square - Opposite block 2-12
Copythorn Road - Alongside no. 193 Copnor Road
Francis Avenue - Outside no's 165-165a
Gatcombe Avenue - Outside no. 44
St Swithun's Road - Outside no. 17
Shadwell Road - Outside no. 115
Tipner Road - Outside no. 39
Velder Avenue - Outside no.17
Wallington Road - Outside no.30
Wykeham Road - Outside no. 17

b) To remove disabled bays in the following locations

3. The bays would be available for use by Blue Badge holders only at all times. The Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the council must be displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle at all times when using the bay.

Persons wishing to object to these proposals must do so by sending their representations to TROteam@portsmouthcc.gov.uk or by post to Traffic Regulation Orders, Parking Team, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Portsmouth PO1 2NE, quoting ref **P023-26** within 21 days of the date of this Notice (i.e. by **10 August 2026**) stating the grounds for the objection.
